1. **Purpose.** This circular announces the relocation of the United States Army Civil Affairs School, Fort Gordon, Georgia.

2. **General.** The United States Army Civil Affairs School, Fort Gordon, Georgia, will relocate to Fort Bragg, North Carolina, during the period 1 August - 15 September 1971. Effective 15 September 1971 the Civil Affairs School will become an integral part of the United States Army Institute for Military Assistance, Fort Bragg, North Carolina. The Civil Affairs School will retain its current identity and will be on a coequal basis with the Special Forces and Military Assistance Schools of the Institute for Military Assistance.
