

## LEADER DEVELOPMENT

1. Leader Development Office (LDO) TDA. Ongoing. No change in status. Appears TRADOC is falling off their position of not providing 7 officers, at least at the action officer level. TRADOC will start documentation procedures shortly. FORSCOM is supporting their requirement although there may be some grade and functional area trade-offs. DAMO-FD is moving out. Should make the current MOC window.
2. Uniformed Army Scientists Working Group (UASWG). Ongoing. No change in status. Effort is beginning to pick up speed. Working group meeting on 17 Jan 1990 went very smoothly. LABCOM IPRs (azimuth checks) are being scheduled: DCSPER - 6 Feb; CG, AMC - 8 Feb; and VCSA - 12 Feb (1000-1030). Personnel policy issues will be handed off to PERSCOM after the 12 Feb brief.
3. Noncommissioned Officer Leader Development Action Plan (NCO LDAP). Ongoing. No change in status. Action agencies working recommendations and are off to a good start. Have current status of all recommendations. Passed copy to CAIG and DCSOPS. LDO will provide formal status update to CSA in 2d Qtr. Not yet scheduled.
4. Civilian Leader Development Action Plan (CIV LDAP). Ongoing. DCSOPS prebrief scheduled for 1500-1545 hrs on 29 Jan 90. Readahead submitted. Have copy of briefing slides. VCSA prebrief scheduled for 1330-1415 hrs on 6 Feb 90. Time and date for CSA (decision brief) being worked. Key leaders have been briefed.
5. ANTAEUS Study. Ongoing. This effort is beginning to taper off. GOWG scheduled for 12 Feb cancelled. Council of Colonels will meet once or twice more. Leader development impacts being identified. Final draft complete.
6. Junior Officer Evaluation Study. Ongoing. No change in status. New name - Criteria Based Assessment Instrument Study. CAL action. They are evaluating the mission. Must develop study concept. Gen Hines has not passed his study material to CAL so they can start. Gen Saint has been briefed. His concerns and comments are being addressed. Hines study material will be passed to BG Miller by the end of Jan 90. Will continue to monitor.
7. RC School and Course Validation. Ongoing. No change in status. TRR has action and details. TRADOC working.
8. MEL-1 Study. Ongoing. No change in status. IPR with CSA on 3 Jan 90 went very well. MEL-1 Study Group is making excellent

progress. CSA comments provided to DCSOPS, DOT and DAMO-TRO. Next Mentor Panel meeting for DCSOPS is tentatively scheduled for 27-28 Mar 90. Final briefing to CSA is scheduled for 1430 hrs 23 Apr 90.

9. DCSOPS Focal Point Actions. Ongoing. No change in status.
10. 629 Ramp Comments. Classified. DCSOPS tasker. Was 90% complete. Units and timings have changed. QUICKSILVER part due to be released to public next week. Needs a re-look.
11. FAO and Personnel Exchange Program Study Group. New initiative. Meetings are taking place.
12. Professional Military Education Report. New action. No change in status. Will monitor input from USAWC and CGSC which is due on 14 Feb 90. Input used for SecArmy report to Congress. SA report due to SECDEF on 1 Mar 90. DAMO-SSP action.
13. Leader Development White Paper. No change in status. CSA tasking to CAL/LDO (came out of SLTC III). First draft complete. Will have copy next week.
14. FAO Council of Officers. DCSOPS has established. Will participate in discussions. First meeting held 0930 hrs, 23 Jan 90. Important issues being addressed. FA 48 is in relatively good shape as compared to many other FAs. Changes being contemplated will only make the FA 48 specialty better.
15. Pre-command Course Study. New LDSS project. Info paper provided to DCSOPS. Waiting feedback from Leavenworth. LDO has drafted message outlining work to be accomplished. Plan is for LTG Wishart to send it out.
16. Officer Education before WWII. New project. Have obtained some material and sources from CMH. Have to review and develop concept. Have some ideas which can be supported by CMH.
