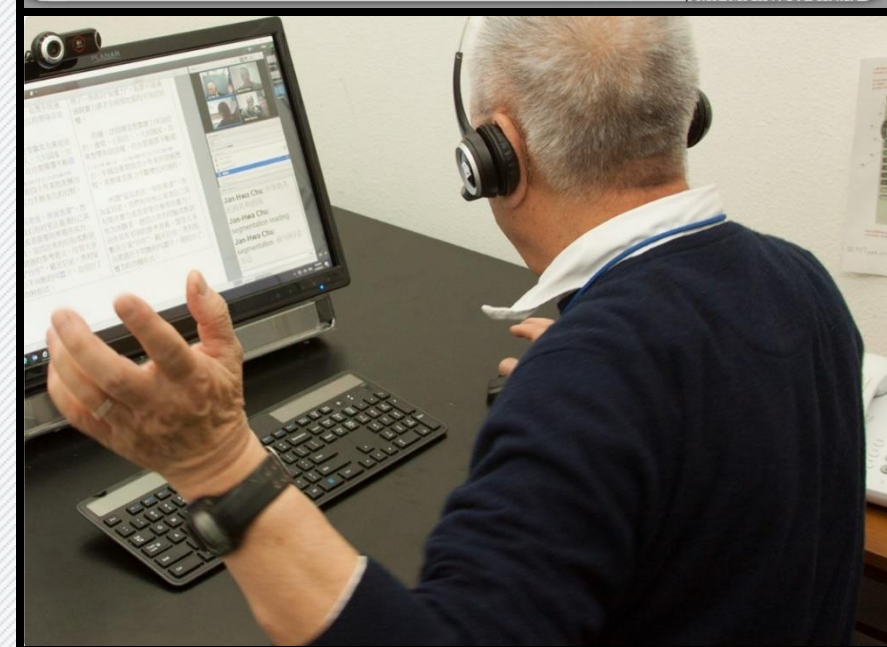
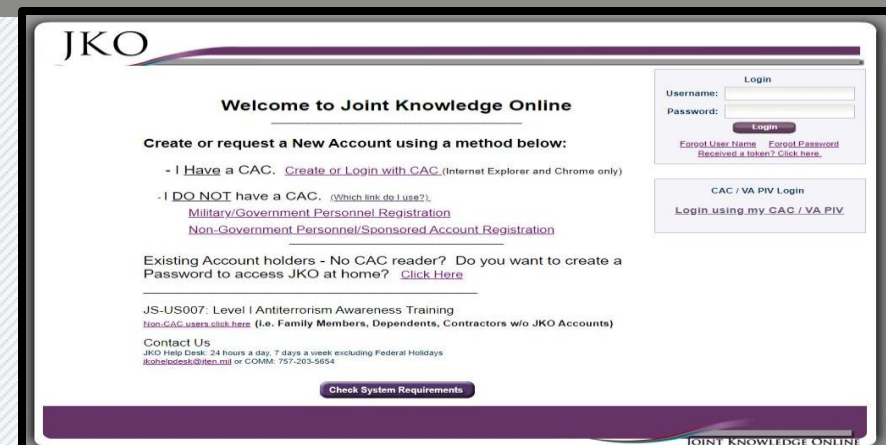
FAO Language Program (FLP)
